## Our Community Health and Wellness Pleage

As a healthcare worker, a community member, a neighbor, a family member and a co-worker; I resolve to uphold best practice standards for myself, and encourage best practice standards for others, as it relates to my personal protection and my honorable responsibility to protect others, in response to COVID-19 Infection Control Precautions.

I pledge to uphold COVID-19 Infection Control Precautions at work, home and in the public by: Contacting my supervisor or Administrator if I, or someone I have been in close contact with, has a

- Practicing good hand hygiene at all times, including vigorous hand and fingernail washing with soap and water or an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

- Regularly cleaning and disinfecting commonly touched surfaces to prevent the spread of infection
- and cross contamination.
- Following good personal hygiene by bathing and laundering work clothes daily.
- Observing and reporting new ideas to protect our work environments, teammates, residents and

  - Sharing new precautions that could improve safety and infection controls.
