



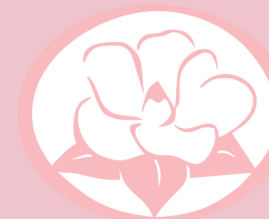

Local quilting group "Bethlehem Peacekeepers" blessed our ladies and staff with the beauty of their art!

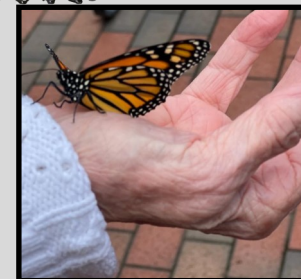


Our ladies were "on cloud9." They could "dig it." They "got their kicks." Our Summer Sock Hop was complete with firefighters, fried food and fifties fashion.
