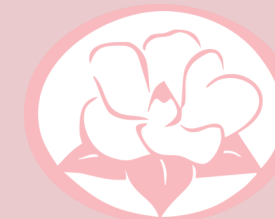
*Meet our Medical Director*

Celebrating 99 Years

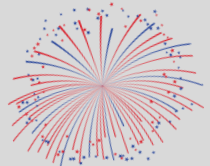

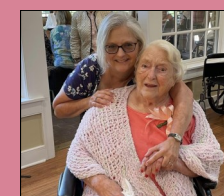
From peer lead painting classes to water games. The ladies home had an exciting summer!
